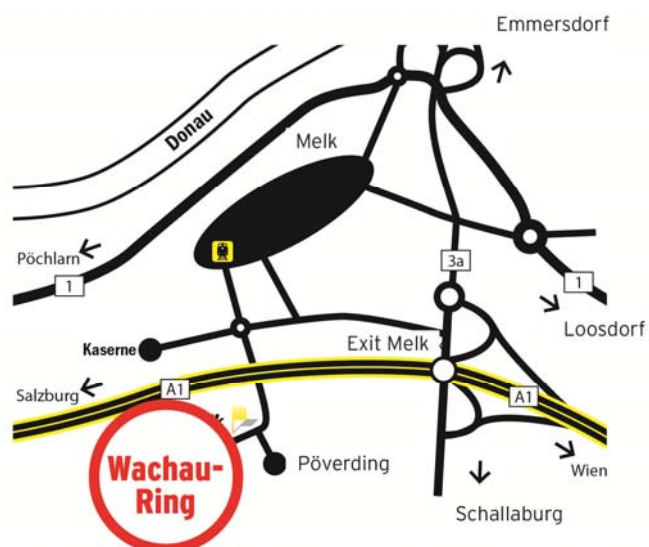


Arrival by public transport
